

BORNEO ADVENTURE; MOUNTAINS & JUNGLES

The Cross Borneo West to East adventure is a real once in a lifetime adventure. Those who have undertaken this trip in the past have describe it as the most challenging and the most enjoyable trekking trip they had ever done. The ultimate challenge - crossing one of the most rugged islands on earth from West to East using roads, rivers and feet, we traverse the jungle of Kalimantan in Indonesian Borneo. To enjoy this trip, you need to be prepared to accept whatever the jungles and rivers serve up! A good fitness level, a strong sense of determination and a flexible attitude are essential.

BORNEO an overview

This expedition gives you the opportunity to trek through Borneo's dense tropical rainforests, through remote villages en-route to the spectacular Mount Kinabalu.

This is a private trip and can be tailored to suit your dates and interests.

We begin with rafting down the Kiulu River, a cycle back up through the beautiful valley, before we begin our trek through the hot humid rainforest and traditional Dusun villages. We camp in villages where few tourists visit and the ladies love to cook for us with food from their farms and show us a little of their cultural dancing and songs. The trek finishes with sun rise on the highest peak of South East Asia, Mount Kinabalu. The view from the summit is spectacular out over the South China Sea. A much rewarded bath in the hot springs is well deserved after the descent. At the end of our trek we head south wildlife spotting at the Kinabatangan Wildlife Reserve and Sepilok Orangutan Sanctuary.

DAY 2: JAKARTA - BALIKPAPAN - MAHAKAM RIVER

Early morning flight to Balikpapan in East Kalimantan and car transfer to the river town of Loajanan, where we will board our house-boat and start travel along the Mahakam River. Continue our travel overnight on the river to reach our next stop.

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Today we will leave our house boat and continue along the river by both speed boat, stopping at a dayak village along the way to learn more about their traditional way of life.

Continue along the river by longboats until we reach the small village of Eheng. Here we will meet our cars and drive to Tering where upon arrival board our speed boat and continue our travel up the Mahakam river to the local village of Long Bagun.

GETTING AROUND

- Transfer to and from the airport will be arranged by us. You other forms for transport will either be a Canoe or your feet!
- Madagascar is notorious for the unreliability of its domestic flights in terms of time. The flights schedules are always subject to change at anytime and often experience cancellations, which are not ideal when following a schedule; this makes it a lot more reliable to travel by road for the most part.
- Distances and times will of course be lengthy due to the vastness of the island and lack of good-quality road systems throughout the country. However, this all adds to the adventurousness of any Madagascar trip; but is definitely something to be aware of whilst travelling around Madagascar.

NB: This itinerary is subject to change – arrangements, routes and facilities are subject to variation depending on local conditions. Please note times given are approximate driving times and do not include stops, the journey times are therefore longer. When driving times are given, this is only an indication. It aims to reflect the actual driving time (and doesn't include stops, lunch, and traffic). The road journeys, while often long, are one of the great ways to experience Madagascar. There is so much life on the road and many photographic opportunities along the way from a natural and people perspective.

WHEN TO GO...

Borneo: November - March (Wet season)

- Throughout the 'wet season' in Borneo, the temperature averages out at 27 degrees.
- Due to the higher rainfall, the rainforests are lusher and green
- The average amount of rainfall through the wet season is 285 millimetres with only an average of 6 hours of sunshine a day.
- There are fewer tourists in Borneo at this time due to the school holidays.

Borneo: April - October (High season)

- In the summer seasons of Borneo, April October is rated one of the best times to go. This because it is perfect conditions for hiking and trekking through the forests.
- In June experience the turtle season off of Lankayan Island
- Ideal time to travel to Borneo if you want to engage in more activities such as Kayaking
