## **WILDLIFE ADVENTURE**

For this amazing Costa Rican adventure – we explore the Osa Penisula in the Cocovado National park, one of the most remote and least visited tourist destinations on the continent.

Described as 'the most biologically intense place on Earth' by National Geographic Magazine, we will raft and trek this rainforest. This is a moderate adventure and is ideal for both adventure seekers and nature lovers who are in are comfortable travelling with limited facilities.



# COSTA RICA, an overview

Eco-diversity like no other - Costa Rica encases 500,000 different species which account for roughly 4% of the world's plant, insect and wildlife species. Witness Sloths, Monkeys, Frogs, Snakes, Turtles, Iguanas, Humming Birds and so much more. # ITINERARY



#### **DAY 1: Arrive into SAN JOSE**

After arriving at Juan Santamaria (SJO) Airport, we will transfer to our hotel in the San Jose City.

The city of San Jose, located in the centre of the country, has served as the main hub for the exploration of Costa Rica. Attractions in San Jose include the National Theatre, the National Museum, the Art Museum or the Pre-Columbian Gold Museum, the picturesque Central Market Place and several art cafes. Shopping also finds its birthplace in San Jose, from the modern malls to the little souvenir shops spread out all over the city.

#### **DAY 2: Begin your RAFTING experience on PACUARE RIVER**

We have an early start this morning as we leave our hotel and head to the Caribbean side of Costa Rica. We will stop en-route for breakfast and arrive at el Cairo of Siquirres to start the first part of our adventure — rafting the Pacuare River. Winding deep inside of one of Costa Rica's most impressive primordial rainforests, the Pacuare River, officially declared a Wild and Scenic River, offers some of the finest white water rafting in Latin America. We will traverse 18 miles of remote and scenic waters that course through a wilderness of dense vegetation, plummeting waterfalls and steep gorges that rise above the riverbanks. The thick undergrowth provides shelter for jaguars, ocelots, monkeys, sloths, and numerous other species of animals and birds. We will stop



on the river at the Rios Tropicales lodge where we will have dinner and stay overnight.

#### **DAY 3: Continue RAFTING on RIVER PACUARE**

In the afternoon we will departure on overland transfer back to San Jose. You will be left to find dinner of your preference in San Jose tonight.



#### **DAY 6: Hike from SIRENA STATION to LA LEONA**



After an early morning start we will set out on a full day trek to La Leona (16 kilometres, 6-7 hours.) We will hike along the sandy beach with several parallel forest trails that are fairly well-marked - Two sections (Salsipuedes and Punta La Chancha) are impassable at high tide. We'll stop en-route for a picnic lunch. The beach trail connecting La Leona and Sirena ranger stations follows the rugged Pacific coastline. The beach winds off into the edge of the forest. Walking can be difficult as the tide rises due to dry sand. You will have dinner at La Leona.

# IMPORTANT INFORMATION

#### **INCLUDED**

- Accommodation in twin hotel/ double shared tents or dormitory as outlined above
- English Speaking local specialist trekking guide
- Regular naturalist and rafting guide during Pacuare rafting
- Meals (B= Breakfast, L= Lunch, S = Snacks/light lunch; D= Dinner) as specified on the itinerary

- Luggage water transportation from Drake Bay to Sirena and from Sirena to La Leona. (We recommend clients only carry day packs with energy food and their daily water supply (camel packs are highly recommended).

#### **NOT INCLUDED**

- Personal expenses (alcoholic drinks, telephone calls etc)
- Snorkel and flippers (these can be hired in town or through the hotel)
- Excess luggage on any flight or during water transfers in Tortuguero or Osa Peninsula, where operators and airlines have a luggage restriction of 25 pounds per person
- Late check-out or early check-in

# WHEN TO GO

- Costa Rica's weather is affected by it proximity to the equator and the varying altitudes, meaning temperatures can vary depending on where about you are in Costa Rica.
- The wet season is roughly between May to the middle of November, with the heaviest rains in September and October. Costa Rica can still be quite pleasant in the wet season with rainy afternoons but sunny mornings.
- The dry season, therefore, is between the middle of November to April, bringing you sunshine and warm temperatures
- Temperatures can be anything from 16°c to 32°c. However, higher altitudes can exceed 0°c during the night.
