

DAY 1: Welcome to SAN JOSÉ

Upon arrival in San José, you will be met at the airport by a Pioneer representative and transferred to your hotel.

DAY 2: Today we will travel to TORTUGUERO on the Caribbean Coast

This morning you have an early morning departure as you head off on the first part of your adventure to Tortuguero National Park. The journey to Tortuguero is by coach followed by boat and we will stop en-route for a typical Costa Rican breakfast. You will arrive at your jungle lodge in time for lunch. This afternoon is a great opportunity to visit the Village of Tortuguero along with your guide. Through this visit you will learn the ways of life of the local residents of Tortuguero. After the visit and some free time, we will return back to the Lodge walking by the trail on the beach directly to the Lodge (weather permitting).

DAY 3: Discover what TORTUGUERO has to offer

This morning after breakfast your naturalist guide will take on a visit to the "Mawamba Park" which includes the butterfly farms, frog farm and garden, biodigestor and gardens. This visit is combined with a walk in the trails at the Lodge. In the afternoon, embark on a canal boat tour through the Tortuguero canals for more opportunities to spot abundant wildlife. This tour introduces you to the rich rainforest and its great array of wildlife.

DAY 4: Transfer from TORTUGUERO to SARAPIOUI

After breakfast at the lodge, we will take the boat ride back to dock before transfer to Guápiles. Here we will have a buffet lunch before meeting our private driver for our transfer to Sarapiqui.


Sarapiqui is known throughout Costa Rica for its amazing and rich biodiversity as well as for being an adventure seeker's dream destination. If you enjoy the outdoors, there are plenty of hiking and nature walk opportunities in this region as well as white water rafting down the River Sarapiqui. A boat trip down the Sarapiqui River is a great way to catch a glimpse of the region's wildlife including; monkeys, birds, turtles and caimans. If you are an avid bird watcher, coming here is the perfect way to see some of Costa Rica's many bird species in their natural environment such as hummingbirds, quetzals, dippers, guans, agoutis and quatamundis.








DAY 5: Enjoy an adrenaline rushing WHITE WATER RAFTING experience on the SARAPIQUI RIVER

DAY 7: Transfer to MONTEVERDE and discover the incredible CLOUD FOREST

After breakfast at the hotel we will transfer by boat to Monteverde and the cloud forests.

Monteverde cloud forest:

Cloud forests are as the name suggests; hazy mist or low lying clouds that cover the upper canopy of the forest. These rare forests cover just 1% of global woodlands and can only be found in tropical and subtropical mountainous areas. The thick layer of clouds makes it more difficult for the sun to break through, providing a slower rate of evaporation, which gives the plants plenty of life-giving moisture, which in turn promotes a huge biodiversity. Monteverde cloud forests is host to 100 species of mammals, 400 species of birds, and 1,200 species of amphibians and reptiles. Additionally, it is also one of the few remaining homes to all 6 species of the cat family; Jaguars, Ocelots, Pumas, Oncillas, Margays and Jagurundis.



After breakfast at the hotel you will get a private transfer back to San José and enjoy the rest of your time at leisure in the city




DAY 9: Transfer from MONTEVERDE to QUIZALES BEACH

ACTIVITY DURATION	2 – 5 hours per day
SEASON	This expedition is open between January and December
BEST TIME TO GO	The driest time of year to travel to Costa Rica is December – April, so this does make a great Christmas and Easter holiday destination.
EXPEDITION SCHEDULE	This is run as a private departure (with some shared excursions) on dates to suit you
DIFFICULTY LEVEL	Our grades have been designated based on our perception of the degree of physical activity you are likely to require to enjoy the adventure. These are only a guideline. This itinerary has a 'Medium' level $(2 - 5$ hours of activities per day). This means that you will need an average level of fitness.
